## HISTORY OF OUR SCHOOL



### Celebrating 40 Years!



Flamingo Road Christian Academy (FRCA) opened its doors in 1983 under the leadership of Mary Hammer with 14 preschool students. Her husband, Bob Hammer, was the first pastor of Flamingo Road Baptist Church, which was started by Sheridan Hills Baptist Church in the late 1970s.

Back in the day, Flamingo Road was a two-lane gravel road with not much around except wildlife. The animals roamed through the campus, oftentimes stopping classes and causing quite a stir.

In 1989, Pastor Dan Southerland became pastor and the church grew by leaps and bounds. Enrollment at FRCA grew right along. The church and school expanded to meet a growing need, thus the current Youth building was built.







Our students were taught the value helping others through volunteering orphanages, at feeding the less fortunate, helping the poor, and collecting clothing for babies and single mothers.

Road Church changed its name to Potential Church and FRCA became Potential Christian Academy. The church and school continued to grow and expand under the leadership of Pastors Troy and Stephanie Gramling. PCA is now blessed to serve over 350 students from K1 - 8th grade!

The school's robust academic, athletic, and spiritual programs continue to thrive. Thousands of families in the community have been impacted by its reach these past 40 years! A good number of alumni have even returned and now fulfill roles that bless students as they were once blessed. This is a further testament to how Potential Church pours into

Phase 2 anticipates securing a permanent location (land and building) for PCA High School.









