Completion of 5th - 8th Grade

We are excited to offer PCA middle school students a dynamic 4-hour STEM and athletics program that blends hands-on learning with engaging sports and athletic activities. This program fosters critical thinking, creativity, teamwork, and physical wellness, promoting academic, social, and physical growth in a Christ-centered environment.



Bottle Rockets & Athletics

Focused on building and launching water rockets, students will learn engineering, aerodynamics, and physics through hands-on projects grounded in Newton's laws of motion. They will design, test, and refine rockets, fostering collaboration, critical thinking, and creativity.



Mousetrap Racecars & Athletics

Focused on building and testing Mousetrap-powered vehicles, students will explore energy, motion, and engineering design, while developing critical thinking, collaboration, and problem-solving skills. By integrating science, technology, math, and creativity, it provides an engaging way for students to deepen their understanding of God's creation.



Model Airplanes & Athletics

2025 Camp Policies

Enrollment

All Summer at PCA enrollment will be submitted online through the PCA Summer Programs portal here: [CAMP REGISTRATION](#) Space is limited, and registrations will be processed online on a first-come, first-served basis until we reach capacity. You will be required to submit an online application for **each** student.

For campers enrolling in Preschool-Aged, School-Aged, Sports, and Middle School STEM/Athletics camps, you must pre-register for each week your child attends. After your initial selections, additional weeks may be added so long as there is availability in the program.

For Reading Intensive Intervention participants, enrollment requires enrollment in the **full** three-week program, no exceptions allowed.

For Summer Speech Therapy – Toddler Play Group participants, this requires enrollment in the **full** three-week program; However, the drop-in class option is available with limited space.

Forms

As a requirement of enrollment, campers are required to provide Potential Christian Academy with a copy of their child's records including their birth certificate, 3040 & 680 health forms. Field trip forms will also be required for all off-campus field trips for School-Age and Sports campers.

Lunch

Campers are responsible for packing and bringing their lunch, snacks, and water. Campers have the option to purchase pizza lunch on Fridays at the cost of \$7.

Snack carts will also be available for purchasing snacks on Movie days via cash only.

Payments

All camp fees, intervention fees, speech fees and incidental expenses will be processed through the PCA Summer Programs online portal. Weekly camp and intervention tuition will be due on the Thursday prior to the start of each week. The speech therapy session fee will be due in full the Thursday prior to the start of the three week session. Any student who has defaulted in payment, may not attend any sessions until their account has been brought up-to-date.

Cancellations

All camp fees and tuition including but not limited to registration fees and weekly tuition are non-refundable and non-transferable week to week, no cancellations will be allowed.
